

English Class – Cycle 3

Topic: Likes & Dislikes + House Vocabulary + There is / There are

1. Warm-up

Game: “Do you like...?”

Teacher asks:

- Do you like pizza?
- Do you like video games?

Students answer:

- Yes, I do / No, I don't

2. Vocabulary – Parts of the House

Teach vocabulary:

- Living room – sala
- Kitchen – cocina
- Bedroom – habitación
- Bathroom – baño
- Dining room – comedor
- Garden – jardín
- Garage – garaje

Activity: Students draw a simple house and label the rooms

3. Grammar – There is / There are

Explain:

- **There is** = hay (singular)
- **There are** = hay (plural)

Examples:

- There is a bed in the bedroom

- There are two chairs in the dining room

Negative:

- There is not (isn't)
- There are not (aren't)

Questions:

- Is there a sofa?
- Are there chairs?

4. Likes and Dislikes

Structure:

- I like + noun
- I don't like + noun

Examples:

- I like my bedroom
- I don't like the kitchen

Add:

- I love / I hate (optional)

- I don't like...

Example:

- There is a bed in my bedroom
- There are two chairs in the kitchen
- I like my living room
