Do + subject + base verb...?

Examples:

Do you like English?

Do you have Science on Monday?

Do you study after school?

Do you bring your notebook every day?

Short Answers

Yes, I do. No, I don't.

After the interview, students present:

Example

"My classmate is Maria. Her favorite subject is English. She studies after school. She brings a notebook and a pencil to class."
