Self-Introduction Dialogue

Katherin: Please allow me to introduce myself. I'm Katherin.

Students: It's great to have you here!

Menoua: Nice to meet you too.

Menoua: Hello, Vanessa!

Katherin: Menoua, this is my friend, Vanessa.
