SIMON – Stars and Constellations

MARTINA – Scorpius

Hello! My name is Martina.

My constellation is **Scorpius**.

Scorpius looks like a **scorpion**.

It is a constellation in the night sky.

SAMUEL HERNANDEZ – Orion

Hello! My name is Samuel.

My constellation is **Orion**.

Orion is a very famous constellation.

It looks like a **hunter**.

It has three bright stars called **Orion's Belt**.

Drawing: Draw Orion and the three stars of his belt.

SAMUEL RAMIREZ – Cassiopeia

Hello! My name is Samuel Ramirez.

My constellation is **Cassiopeia**.

Cassiopeia looks like the letter **W**.

It has five bright stars.

It is easy to find in the night sky.

Drawing: Draw the W shape with five stars.

SALOME GONZALEZ – Gemini

Hello! My name is Salome.

My constellation is **Gemini**.

Gemini means **twins**.

It represents two brothers, **Castor and Pollux**.

Gemini is a beautiful constellation.

Drawing: Draw two people and stars around them.

SARA AYALA – Cygnus

Hello! My name is Sara.

My constellation is **Cygnus**.

Cygnus looks like a **swan**.

It is also called the **Northern Cross**.

We can see it in the night sky.

Drawing: Draw a swan using stars.

MARTIN LINARES – Ursa Minor

Hello! My name is Martin Linares.

My constellation is **Ursa Minor**.

Ursa Minor means **Little Bear**.

It is famous because it has the **North Star**, Polaris.

Drawing: Draw the Little Bear and Polaris.

DANIEL – Pisces

Hello! My name is Daniel.
My constellation is **Pisces**.
Pisces means **fish**. 
It represents two fish in the sky.
Pisces is one of the twelve zodiac constellations.
Thank you!

Drawing: Draw two fish connected by stars.

VELANDA – Ursa Major

Hello! My name is Velanda.
My constellation is **Ursa Major**.
Ursa Major means **Great Bear**.
It is famous for the **Big Dipper**.
We can see it in the northern sky.
Thank you!

Drawing: Draw the Big Dipper using seven stars.

SANTIAGO OROZCO DRACO – The Dragon

Hello! My name is Santiago Orozco.
My constellation is **Draco**.
Draco means **dragon**.

It looks like a long, winding dragon in the sky.
Draco is near **Ursa Major and Ursa Minor**.

Hello everyone!

Today, we are going to show you our **homemade constellation project**.

For this project, we need:

-  A cup
-  A piece of paper
-  A constellation
-  A pencil
-  Something to make small holes
-  Glue
-  A flashlight

First, we draw a **constellation** on the paper.

Then, we make **small holes** on the stars.

The holes are like the stars in the sky.

Next, we put the paper on the cup.

We use glue to keep the paper in place.

Then, we put the **flashlight inside the cup**.

Now, we turn off the lights.

We point the cup at the wall.

Look!

We can see the **constellation on the wall!**

The small holes let the light pass through.

GUSTAVO Student 5:

This is like looking at stars in the night sky.

The flashlight is like the **light**, and the holes look like **stars**.

Our constellation is now on the wall!
